DAG tickets are no longer available for purchase.

Grads who have pre-purchased tickets to the Dry After Grad will be required to drop off a bag containing a change of clothes prior to leaving for the Dinner/Dance (see below for a schedule timeline)

IMPORTANT:

DAG is an **Alcohol, Drug, and Vape/Smoke-Free Party**, supervised by parent volunteers and security personnel. Please note that this event is organized entirely by parent volunteers. Even with all the proper care and precautions, accidents can happen. Purchasing the DAG ticket and attending the event confirms the voluntary participation of Grade 12 kids in any/all the activities planned for the night. The parent, caregivers, and any other related/unrelated individuals waive any and all claims and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Board of Education of School District No.38 and its officers, employees, agents, parent volunteers, and representatives, and the Ministry of Education for any personal injury, death, property damage, or loss sustained because of your child’s participation in the DAG event cause whatsoever, including negligence.

STRICTLY ENFORCED:

- No in/out privileges or going to a vehicle to get something. Once you leave, you will **not** be allowed back into the event and you will not be refunded your \$90 ticket.
- No cars will be allowed to park at the school overnight. (Does not apply to parent chaperones)
- We **do not** suggest that your kids drive home as they will be up all night.
- You must sign in when you arrive and sign out when you leave. If you intend to leave before 6am, a parent/guardian will be required to come in and sign you out
