# Valedictory Guest Ticket Sales Round 1 (May 8 – 10)

For those students who have already paid the Valedictory fee of \$60, they will receive two (2) guest tickets at the rehearsal. GRADS DO NOT REQUIRE A TICKET.

Upcoming in person ticket sales are for those who wish to purchase more than the two guest tickets. Ticket sales will begin, IN PERSON, on Wednesday, May 8<sup>th</sup> to Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup> outside the main office during LUNCH ONLY. Purchases are to be CASH or CHEQUE (made payable to Matthew McNair Secondary School); there will be no electronic payment available. Tickets cost \$10 each.

Every student who has paid the Valedictory fee, is guaranteed the opportunity to purchase four (4) additional tickets, however, you can buy fewer if you don't require four. If there are remaining tickets, we will announce an additional date for purchase. There will be no refunds on sold tickets.

Valedictory will be taking place on Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at The Chan Center for the Performing Arts (UBC) from 7:00pm – 10:00pm. Approximately a week or two prior to Valedictory we will send out additional information regarding arrival time and parking.

The Anniversary of the Canadian Human Rights Tribunal first non-compliance order called for Canada to fully implement Jordan's Principle by May 10, 2016. Jordan's Principle ensures First Nations children receive the services and supports they need when they need them.
