Take Our Kids to Work 2022 will carry on in partnership with **The Students Commission of Canada** (SCC). Since 1994, **Take Our Kids to Work Day** has grown from a regional program into a nation-wide project involving more than 200,000 Grade 9 students and 75,000 workplaces. Career Education curriculum supports students as they begin to identify and develop personal interests, passions and competencies. Learning from work-related experiences helps to foster this growing awareness.

Wednesday, November 2, 2022, is the date of this year's event. Grade 9 students across Canada will go to work with a parent, relative, or adult friend (students may also go with a classmate's parent).

Learning first-hand about work and a range of career opportunities is an integral part of the Health and Career Education curriculum. **Take Our Kids to Work Day** will provide students with some or all of the following benefits:
